We had partly finalized all the arrangement for the 6th Asian Science Editors' Conference and Workshop, July 13-14th 202, Malaysia at Berjaya Times Square Hotel, but due the Covid-19 pandemic the CASE committee decided to cancel the conference.

The local organizing committee is hoping that Malaysia can still host the conference in 2021. Currently, the Covid-19 pandemic is under control in Malaysia and we are confident that by 2021 we will be allowed to host conferences with certain standard operating procedures by the Ministry of Health Malaysia.





Council of Asian Science Editors (CASE)

CASE is a non-governmental, non-partisan, and non-profit organization, CASE aims to improve the quality of science journals published in Asia through consulting and information exchange regarding editing and publishing in order to contribute to the development of science and human well-being.

History

In recent years, the quality of scientific research in Asia has continuously improved and, accordingly, scholars in Asia are publishing a greater number of research papers. However, because a majority of outstanding papers are being published in non-Asian journals, many of the research papers that are being published in Asia have not drawn the international readership that they deserve.

In order to further the improvement of Asian scientific research publication necessary for international attention, the cooperation of nations across Asia to achieve a synergistic effect is needed to further the cause and reputation of Asian journals as destination for top research.

Toward this end, the Korean Council of Science Editors (KCSE) & has prioritized scholarly exchange among editors in Asia for several years. In particular, 18 editors from a few Asian countries gathered at the Korean Federation of Science and Technology Societies (KOFST) on October 1, 2013 and agreed that an organization dedicated to the advancement of scientific research publication across Asia is needed. Thus, the Council of Asian Science Editors (CASE) was conceived.

CASE encourages editors-in-chief, managing editors, manuscript editors, and anyone who is interested in science publication to participate in order to promote and support journals and scientific publication in Asia.
